WP 1: Experiential Education in Health Professions: the Need for Change

Month 1: ReFEEHS Kick – off Meeting and Introductory Symposium (Thematic Workshop 1)

Months 1-4

<u>Survey</u> on the RS students, teaching staff and practitioners attitudes related to Experiential Education, Inter-professional Education and Teaching Competences Development

Month 4 (February, 2016)

<u>Report</u>: Experiential Education in Health Professions: the Need for Change which will serve as a resource and reference for further project activities



2.1. Experiential Education and Inter-professional Education curriculum development (Months 4 - 24)

- identification of EE and IPE competency based learning outcomes;
- development of relevant educational contents and resources;
- verification of curricula updates at each RS HEI;

2.2. Development od Quality Assurance System for Experiential Education (Months 4 - 24)

- provision of well-planned, outcomes-focused practical experience with adequate supervision and assessment by qualified teacher practitioners with learning-rich practice environment;
- o definition of academic, legal and professional requirements for student practical placements;
- development of relevant documents including students' and teacher practitioners' handbooks and guidelines, legal forms required, and agreements;
- establishment of the relevant Codes of Professional Conduct;



- 2.3. Development of the Experiential Education E-platform (Months 4 24)
- establishment of the E-platform for EE management and administration, including placement sites and teacher practitioners' databases;
- **2.4. Educational Equipment purchase and installation** (Months 5 18/Dec 2017)
- 2.5. Policy for Professional Development of Health Professionals Educators (Month 24/Oct, 2017)
- o the Policy proposal to be submitted for review and approval to the relevant university and governmental authorities;



2.6. Teaching Certificate Program in Health Professionals Education (Month 24/October 2017)

- development of Teaching Certificate in Health Professionals' Education course which will be accredited as a continuous professional education course for academic staff and teacher practitioners;
- development of relevant educational resources aimed at blended learning educational model;
- 12 RS teaching staff will be enrolled in the specific postgraduate courses in Health Professionals' Education and recruited as future Teaching Certificate tutors;



Each Partner institution will host one major project event:

- 4 thematic workshops and conferences will be organized at each of the RS HEIs;
- 4 structured study visits of the key RS project team members to the EU HEIs (2 visits in the first, and 2 visits in the second project year);
- individual study visits of the RS academic staff to EU partner institutions: teaching competencies development through job shadowing and participation in the relevant educational activities;

to explore and discuss

- 1) different approaches to experiential education in health sciences education;
- 2) quality assurance requirements related to EE;
- 3) experiences related to development and delivery of interprofessional education;
- 4) models for teaching competencies development and evaluation;



WP 3: Implementation of the Framework for Experiential Education

3.1. Implementation of the Reinforced Experiential Education Curriculum (Months 25 - 35)

- all final year students of health sciences will be enrolled in the updated experiential education courses;
- students' professional competencies will be assessed pre and after the exposure to the updated curricula;

3.2. Introduction of Inter-professional modules and courses (Months 25 - 35)

- Interprofessional modules will be introduced in the existing didactic courses dealing with the introduction to profession, professional ethics, roles and responsibilities;
- Interprofessional modules will be introduced in the updated experiential education courses and linked to the relevant competency-based outcomes for each health sciences profession;
- joint interprofessional courses will be implemented at a pilot scale during the third project year with the contribution of academic staff from all the health sciences study programmes;



WP 3: Implementation of the Framework for Experiential Education

3.3. E-platform exploitation and testing (Months 25 - 36)

- o Experiential education E-platform will be adopted for exploitation at each of the RS HEIs;
- course coordinators will test the functionality of the platform and list the recommendations for improvement;
- feedback will also be gathered from students and teacher practitioners/clinical supervisors;

3.4. Teaching Certificate in Health Professionals Education course delivery (Months 25 - 36)

- the first cohort of 40 academic staff and teacher practitioners will be admitted to the newly developed Teaching Certificate Programme in the third project year;
- balanced group of academic staff and teaching practitioners/clinical supervisors will be admitted,
 with the equal representation of different health professions;



WP 4: Project Monitoring & Quality Assurance

4.1. Internal Quality Plan (Month 6, April 2016)

- Quality Working Group members will define Quality Plan in line with the proposed project workplan;
- Quality Plan will include procedures, standards/checklists for reviews, metrics to measure process quality and project quality goals, key performance indicators and corrective and preventive actions (CAPA);
- Quality Working Group will be responsible to define Partnership Agreement terms and conditions and monitor their fulfillment, including ownership/copyright of the project results.

- Quality Working Group will prepare bi-annual quality reports on the activities accomplished, potential problems and delays;
- Quality reports will be evaluated by the Project Steering Committee and University of Belgrade International Relations Office. They will also be submitted to National Erasmus+ Office.


