9 out of 10 students wish that mobile health would be addressed more in their education


58% wish that mobile health would be addressed in the compulsory practice integrated in the degree.

Inter-professional education and collaboration







Which interprofessional educational opportunities does your faculty offer?




Does your student association(s)

75% students would like to interact or do practical work together with other healthcare students during the course




"I envision myself working as part of inter-professional healthcare team."
