
- HE and research, the academic world always in a global space

- The geopolitics of higher education




## Hungarian HE

- Series of mergers as policy has been changing (question of stability?)
- Until 2015: 69 institutions of HE
  - 24 universities: 18 public, 5 church-affiliated, 1 private
  - 45 colleges: 13 public, 25 church-affiliated, 11 private
- Recent law on HE: yet another round of 'rationalization'
- New, government founded and –funded university: National University of Public Service (created in 2012)
- New system of management introduced in 2015: the Chancellor dual leadership (internal competition, power games)
- In general: demographic pressures







- new BA, MA programs in International Studies












## No. of incoming int'l students at the UP





## Bottom-up programme-making

- Since July 2015
- In WS's
- Constant consultation with deans and faculty councils
- Both centers of management Rector and Chancellor
- Committee work
- Strategic Programme document ready last step taken on 3 November with the Senate's decision made



## Internationalization Strategic Programme

- Not only/merely IR/external relations strategy, but INTERNATIONALIZATION, to be able to respond to demands of globalization
- For the period: 2015–**2020**
- Central aim: to double the no. of incoming int'l students until 2020
- Task: the UP becomes international from within! Internationalization at home!
- Needed: coherent, with less ad hoc solutions than in the past to turn into a proactive, strategy-minded daily reality, getting rid of the 'follower' type of the past
- Program-based, rational context: directives + annual actions, measurable indicators – Annual Action Plans and their constant evaluation
- Sharing knowledge within (internal best practice), improving internal communication
- All these need professional coordination **Center for IR** 'open, cooperative, service-orinted' approach encouraging a new type of cooperation culture



## Major strategic goals – 4 Action Areas

- Internal thinking about ourselves
- Strategic collaboration with students and their associations
- Collaborative framework with the city, county, region
- Competencies development program, trainings
- How to become (more) unique
  - good opportunity: 650th jubilee
- Action Area I: Changing internal institutional attitudes; encouraging internal knowledge sharing (there are unused strategically plausible reserves)
- Action Area II: Prioritizing international partnerships
- Action Area III: Professionalizing student recruitment, improving student servicies
- Action Area IV: Developing activities, tools, sub-programmes to increase the unique features of the UP, therefore, to increase its competitiveness and attractiveness globally

- Launching the 'University Ambassador' Scholarship Programme for faculty
- New, enhanced coordination of recruiting agencies' activities
- Stipendium Gala
- International Spring as part of the 'PTE Brand'
- Study Abroad programmes and Summer Schools
- Introduction of 'dreamApply!'
- Coordinated and concerted efforts to hold entrance examinations abroad in collaboration with other HEIs
- Major contribution to the success of the Jubilee Project increased visibility via annual meetings, conferences, etc. Incl. HE Donald Tusk becoming Honoris Causa on December 8th, 2017
