- Contemporary recommendations and standards for dental students include experiential education in a real working environment for at least six months.

- Learning based on experience provides students an opportunity to be involved in a real professional activity with real consequences,
- in an environment that provides enough opportunities for learning with continuous supervision, support and assessment of progress by the subject teacher

- Due to the specific organization of dental care within the health system RS and due comprehensive practical training that exists in integrated studies dentistry student professional practice is organized in the framework of final clinical courses.

- Final clinical course is a form of teaching that includes practical work of students in order to fulfill theoretical, academic knowledge and establishing a connection with the practical knowledge and experience necessary for their future work.

- Inclusion in real professional activities with real consequences, in direct contact with patients and other health professionals
- in an environment that provides ample opportunities for learning and supervision, support and assessment of progress by teachers of different specialties

Practical teaching within the final clinical course can be defined as:

- part-time,
- short-term,
- a self-guided and / or approved and / or determined by teachers instructions

The course objective

- is that students perceive interrelations and interdependence in all fields of dentistry, as well as to systematize previously acquired knowledge and skills in all dental specialities.
