M.Sc. in Advenced Practice Nurse

The development of a training and related competences, which provides the possibility to transfer some scope of duties to MSc nurses which currently belongs to physicians.

M.Sc. in Advenced Practice Nurse

International Council of Nurses:

APN is a registered nurse, who:

"has acquired the expert knowledge base, complex decision-making skills and clinical competencies for expanded practice"

(Delimaire, 2010)

The effects of training in the care system I.

- Cost reduction (already reflected in the training cost) (Hussey, 2009; Delimaire, 2010)
- Contributing to meet the increased demand, improvement of the access to health care and patient satisfaction increase (Aiken, 2008; Aiken, 2014)
- Mortality rates improve (Yakusheva, 2014)
- Waiting time decreases (Delamaire, 2010)
- Nursing profession can be more attractive (Delimaire, 2010)
- The rate of attrition and migration decrease (7% Kleinpell, 2005)

- Anesthesiology

- Adult community care
- Pediatric community care
- Perioperative/first assistant surgeon specialization for APN

APN with intensive patient care specialization

Competencies eg.:

- Compilation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry tests
- Prescribing
- Central venous cannula insertion
- Intubation
- Abdominal tapping
- Lumbar puncture
- Sternal puncture
- Thoracentesis

Efficiency:

- Shorter hospitalisation time
- Less complications

(AANA, 2012; Kleinpell, 2005, Klinpell, 2008)

APN specialization in anesthesiology

Competencies eg.:

- Individual anaesthesia
- Compliation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry tests
- Prescribing

Efficiency:

The number and quality of complications in anesthesia did not show difference compared to the same activity carried out by the anesthetist.

(AANA, 2007; AANA 2009)

APN with emergency specialization

Competencies eg.:

- Compilation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry and imaging diagnostic tests
- Prescribing
- Physical examinations
- Settting up direction diagnosis
- Central venous cannula insertion
- Intubation
- Abdominal tapping
- Lumbar puncture
- Sternal puncture
- Thoracentesis
- Gastric lavage

Efficiency:

- Shorter waiting time
- Faster, smoother patient care

(Li, 2013; Royal college of Nursing, 2007; Wennike, 2007)

APN with geriatric specialization

Competencies eg.:

- Individual work in praxis with community care
- Compilation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry and imaging diagnostic tests
- Prescribing
- Setting up direction diagnosis
- Preventive examinations
- Sending to special medical consultation
- Ordering and prescribing vaccines

Efficiency:

- Decreasing nursing/ operating costs in nursing homes, home care
- Reduction in the frequency of appearance in emergency wards and in the number of days spent in hospital

(Mundinger, 2000; GAPNA, 2012; Kane, 1989)

APN specialization in adult community care

Competencies eg.:

- Individual work in praxis with community care
- Compilation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry and imaging diagnostic tests
- Prescribing
- Setting up direction diagnosis
- Sending to special medical consultation
- Ordering and prescribing vaccines

Efficiency:

• In individual practices the level of satisfaction reached the level of doctors in case of simple diseases such as: cold, flu, high blood pressure, care for other chronic diseases

(Hooker, 2001; AANP, 2013)

APN specialization in pediatric community care

Competencies eg.:

- Individual work in praxis with community care
- Compilation of treatment plans
- Ordering and analysing blood chemistry and imaging diagnostic tests
- Prescribing
- Setting up direction diagnosis
- Sending to special medical consultation
- Ordering and prescribing vaccines

Efficiency:

• Reduced number of hospital admissions, improved cure rate in patients

(MO'Leary, 2013; Sherwood, 1997)

APN with perioperative/surgical first assistant specializations

Competencies eg.:

First assistant tasks during operations:

- separation of tissues, stitching, staples
- Laparoscopic trocar insertion and removal
- Inserting and removing drain tube
- Closure of wounds outside fascia
- Limb vein preparation
- Wound treatment

Efficiency:

- Shorter surgical waiting list
- 50% cost reduction (shorter operation time, reduced HR costs)
- Increased satisfaction

(RN-SFA, 2009; McKenzie, 2012; Board of Registered Nursing, 2011)

Further specializations (plan)

- Health Sciences Educator specialization
- Research specialization
- Institute Director Nurse specialization

Admission Requirements for MSc education

Currently:

BSc nursing degree - all specializations

Ambulance Officer for Bsc graduates - emergency or intensive patient care specialization

Future:

for all students of health sciences with BSc qualification - specialization in health sciences educator

- availability of state-funded education
- Application in sample hospitals and
- the monitoring of activities, examining the efficiency of education in everyday practice.
