The ICGP

- The professional body for general practice in Ireland
- The college has 4,156 members; comprising over 85% of practising GPs in the Republic of Ireland
- o The activities of the ICGP include:
 - Training and education at undergraduate and postgraduate levels
 - Accreditation of specialist training programmes in general practice
 - The College is the examining body for Membership in General Practice
 - Public relations and interaction with the media on behalf of the profession
 - Promotion of continuing education, professional development and research



Research department

 The main aim is to develop and support research and audits in general practice in a structured format

Undergraduate Medical Education

- In Ireland there are 6 undergraduate medical schools
- Undergraduate / Graduate Entry
 - 5 years Medical training- registered doctor
 - 1 year Internship
 - 6 months General Surgery
 - 6 months General Medicine



- Undergraduates and general practice
 - More exposure to general practice at the earlier stages of medical education
 - Increasing number of GPs who are engaged in undergraduate teaching



GP Training





- >170 intake per year, 14 schemes
- 340 training practices
- Competition ratio for places 1.9
- 66-82% retention within GP
- Attrition 0.3%



Structure of Training



4 years duration:

2 hospital, 2 in training practices

Protected time theory course ½ day a week in 1st 2 years.

Protected time theory course full day in 2nd two years.




10 components GP Training (5)

Governance structure





Irish Professional Competence Schemes (PCS)

- Formal structure to assist doctors in meeting their Continuous
 Professional Development (CPD) requirements
- Introduced in May 2011 for all registered medical practitioners
- Regulated by the Irish Medical Council (IMC)
- Medical Practitioners are assisted in meeting their requirements by one of 13 Postgraduate Medical Training Bodies
- o PCS year: 1st May 30th April



Medical Council Requirements



- o 50 CPD credits (minimum):
 - √ 20 External (knowledge/skills)
 - √ 20 Internal (practice evaluation/development)
 - ✓ 5 Personal Learning
 - √ 5 additional credits



Medical Council Requirements (cont.)

1 annual audit (clinical or practice)

"Audit is a quality improvement process that follows a systematic review and evaluation of activities against research-based standards. An audit is a continuous process of aiming to improve patient care and practice excellence."



- Recording & evidence
- Statement of Participation proof of engagement with a Scheme
- o Random checks as part of regulation of the Scheme:
 - > IMC random audit process
