New regulation in 2016 in Hungary

- Ministerial decree 18/2016. (VIII. 5.) EMMI provided new regulatory framework on the requirements of B.Sc. And M.Sc. Programmes
 - Appendix I of the ministerial decree describes general competencies of higher education degrees
 - Appendix III describes competencies for specific B.Sc. programmes
 - Appendix IV describes competencies for specific M.Sc. programmes

How is competence defined ?

- A mixture of:
 - Knowledge
 - Ability
 - Attitude
 - Autonomy and responsibility

General higher education competencies include:

- Information literacy
- Knowledge of digital educational contents
- Health promotion
- Basics of sustainable development
- Environmental protection
- Accident prevention
- Work safety
- Consumer protection

Subject specific higher education competencies include:

- Specific competencies for each qualification
- Both at B.Sc. and M.Sc. levels
- Detailed description of knowledge, ability, attitude, autonomy and responsibility for each subject

Elements of knowledge in medical education

- Medical doctor is expected to know:
- Structure and functions of the human body
- Structure, networks and reactions of biological molecules
- Principles of operation, area of use and practical application of medical equipments
- Structure and function of the health care system and health insurance system

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Elements of <u>ability</u> in medical education

- Medical doctor is able to:
- Perform a general patient examination, history taking and physical examination
- Provide basic and advanced life support (BLS and ALS)
- Communicate with a dying patient and his or her family members
- Prescribe medicines in an accurate and understandable way
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Elements of <u>attitude</u> in medical education

- Regarding attidunal requirements a medical doctor should be:
- Sensitive to the psycho-social status of patients
- Committed to scientific evidences and evidence based medicine
- Treat personal and medical information with confidentially
- Comply with and apply existing legislation

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Elements of <u>autonomy and responsibility</u> in medical education

- Medical doctor's autonomy includes:
- Providing first aid according to best practice guidlines
- Being committed to health promotion at individual and population levels
- Taking part in continous education / life long learning

- Credits: 360
- Semesters: 12
- Practice: min. 65 %
- University: 4
 - Budapest
 - Debrecen
 - Pécs
 - Szeged

Practical education in medicine

- Summer practice:
 - Nursing
 - Internal medicine
 - Surgery
- Internship in the 6th year:
 - Internal medicine
 - Surgery
 - Pediatrics
 - Gynecology and obstetrics
 - Neurology
 - Psychiatry
